Moving to a sober house after addiction treatment is important to sustaining long-term sobriety. The longer that an addict can separate themselves from their old life of addiction, the better chance they have at staying sober. The sooner after treatment the recovering addict goes back to their old environment, the higher the chance that they might relapse.

All of the residents are involved in recovery. The strong sense of community among the residents is created from sharing a firm commitment to recovery. Resident's work together using skills learned in treatment to support one another in early sobriety. Adjusting to life in the outside world can be a serious challenge for the newly sober addict or alcoholic. Attendance of 12-step meetings help the newly sober person to make connections with other drug addicts and alcoholics who have insight and wisdom as well as practical advice to share with newly sober people to develop individual recovery.
